Fall 16' ALL IN Action Plan

As the ALL IN Campus Democracy Challenge is working to recognize post-secondary campuses committed to improving democratic engagement, the Wagner College ALL IN Democracy team is committed to increasing civic consciousness, boosting voter turnout and broadening the scope of political discourse on campus and in our communities. We seek to complete these goals through the following means:

September:

Constitution Day Celebration- 9/22/16

- In partnership with the Wagner College Center for Leadership & Community Engagement, the ALL IN Democracy team celebrated the signing of the most influential American document, the U.S. constitution. We began the day by announcing our commitment to the ALL IN Campus Democracy Challenge at our Constitution Day table in the Student Union. Further, we registered students via ALL IN partner Turbovote and handed out constitutions to all student registrants.
- In the evening, we were joined by filmmaker, Julie Winokur- creator of the *Bring it to the Table* project. *Bring it to The Table* is a documentary film and community engagement campaign aimed at engaging students in civic action and empowering them to take an active role in breaking down hyper-partisanship. This event was attended by 35 of our student peers, and worked to initiate campus dialogue around political discourse.

National Voter Registration Day- 9/27/16

- In partnership with the Wagner College President's Office, our ALL IN Democracy Team is encouraging our campus to register in celebration of National Voter Registration Day. Our first step in making this push, is a campus wide e-mail from our President, Dr.Richard Guarasci- This email includes our registration link wagner.turbovote.org
- In the evening, our ALL IN Democracy Team will be registering voters in our campus residence halls. During our tabling sessions, we will be sharing resources that will help students to understand the context of this election.

Presidential Debate Screening- 9/26/16

• In support of Wagner College's Hugh L. Carey Institute for Government Reform, the All-In Democracy Team will be registering voters throughout the screening of the first Presidential Debate of this election cycle.

October:
